## **ATR MAY RATE Vote FOR Motion to Recommit H.R. 986, “Eightmile River Act”**

H.R. 986, the “Eightmile Wild and Scenic River Act”, introduced by Representative Joe Courtney (CT-2, D), is further illustration of increasing government control and regulation of the American taxpayer.

While H.R. 986 is a direct example of unjust government land takings, it also represents a violation of the basic freedoms and liberties our Founding Fathers set out to prevent. Government abuse is increasing on all levels and a vote for H.R. 986 is a vote for increased size and scope of the government **UNLESS the Motion to Recommit is approved.**

Mr. Bishop of Utah moves to recommit the bill H.R. 986 to the Committee on Natural Resources with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

At the end of the bill, add the following:

(j) CLARIFICATION.—No Federal funds may used to 1 condemn land to carry out the purposes of this Act or 2 the amendment made by subsection (b).

ATR is urging Congress to condemn the use of Federal funds to seize private property by supporting Mr. Bishop’s motion.
