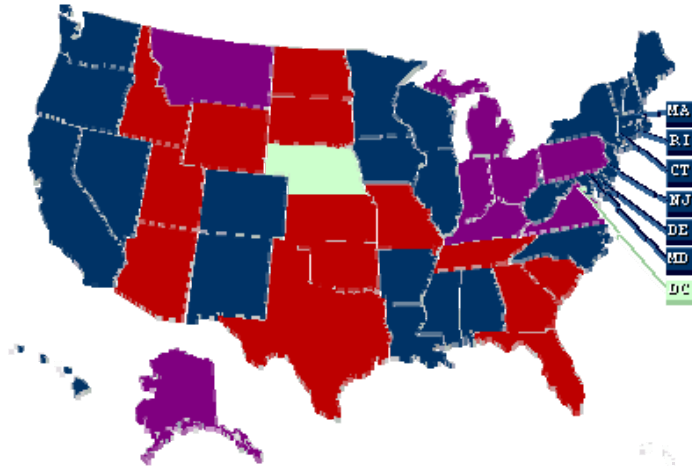

- Democrat (27): AL, AR, CA, CO, CT, DE, HI, IL, IA, LA, ME, MD, MA, MN, MS, NC, NH, NJ, NM, NY, NV, OR, RI, VT, WA, WI, WV
- Split (8): AK, IN, KY, MI, MT, OH, PA, VA

### Summary of 2008 Election Chamber Changes

#### To Republican control:

- Montana Senate
- Tennessee House
- Oklahoma Senate (from tie)
- Tennessee Senate (from tie)

#### To Democrat control:

- Delaware House
- New York Senate
- Nevada Senate
- Ohio House
- Wisconsin Assembly

#### To Tie:

- Alaska Senate (from GOP)
- Montana House (from Dem)
